

Measures that are in effect

Curfew 11:00 pm to 5:00 am



SHOPPING

- 1 person per family.
- Supermarkets and Hardware Stores must limit their clientele to 50%, by using 50% less carts or baskets.
- It is advised to also wear a mask outside in case 1.5 m distance cannot be maintained.
- Closing time is 10:00 pm.



SCHOOL

- Schools will open again on Monday, April 12.
- Hygiene measures should be applied more strictly.
- Parents may not go up or be on the school grounds.
- There may be no physical contact between teachers and students.
- All students over the age of 13 must wear a mask on the school grounds.



AREA AND ASSEMBLY BAN / AGGLOMERATION

- Gathering in public spaces like parking lots, the beach or on reefs is prohibited from 7:30pm to 5am.
- It is not permitted to be on the reefs during curfew.
- Gathering ban: no more than two people can gather.
- Camping is not permitted.
- "Drive by" or "Drive thru" celebrations are now permitted.



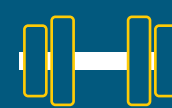
FOOD & BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS

- A maximum of 4 people (adults) can sit at a restaurant table (protocol not applicable for children under the age of 12).
- Dancing is prohibited.
- Bars remain closed.
- Standing or sitting at a bar is prohibited.
- Standing inside a restaurant is prohibited, you must be seated to be served.
- Closing time is 10:00 pm.



SPORTS

- Organized sports for participants of all ages are allowed. There is no limit to the number of coaches/trainers that can be present, but there can be no audience.
- The sporting event must be affiliated with ASU, COA, or it must be registered with IBISA.
- Must register names of those who are going to practice/compete, always with dates for a period of 2 weeks and for all ages.
- IBISA will be controlling.
- Bush League and Contact Sports of all ages are not yet permitted.



GYM

Can reopen, following strict protocols.



FUNERALS

A maximum of 10 people are allowed to attend a funeral indoors simultaneously.



ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Drinking alcohol in public places like on the beach, in a parking lot, or on a reef is prohibited. Having alcohol in your possession with the intention to drink it in a public place is also prohibited.



SOCIAL GATHERING AT HOME

- Social activities (like having guests over) at home are prohibited.
- Limited family visits and visits from caretakers or doctors are allowed.



AT SEA

Large gatherings on boats and yachts are prohibited; no more than 4 people at a time. Catamarans and charter boats are allowed to operate at a maximum capacity of 50%.



RETIREMENT HOMES

Retirement homes must adhere to specific precautionary measures.



MUSICAL ENTERTAINMENT

Musical entertainment is allowed with just 1 musician. The music must serve as background music.



PERMITS FOR PUBLIC ACTIVITIES

Permits for public activities during this period of time will not be granted.
